CASE RATE UPDATE

- Monroe's 2-week rolling case rate has gone down again, now at averaging just over 4 new cases per day.
- Our 2-week case is 22.0 cases per 100,000 population.
- As of yesterday's report, Monroe has had 1,388 cases, and 15 deaths, since the start of the pandemic.

VACCINATION

- Monroe continues to run vaccination clinics on Wednesdays.
- In addition to making an appointment through VAMS, we are now welcoming walk-ins between 11am – 2pm.
- We are currently offering both Moderna and Johnson & Johnson vaccine.

STATE RULES STARTING MAY 1ST

As announced previously, starting tomorrow:

- The curfew for restaurants, entertainment venues, recreation venues, and theaters will be moved to midnight.
- Outdoors:
 - Establishments may serve alcohol without food.
 - The 8-person per table limit is lifted.
